All abstracts within 150 words (with 4 to 5 keywords) and full papers (within 1500 words) must be submitted in MS Word format and Times New Roman front with 12 front size (normal) for text and 14 front size (bold) for heading and 1.5 spacing in APA 7th manual model citations and references. Each abstract/ full paper should contain title, subtheme, author name, his/her designation, affiliation along with her/her WhatsApp number and email-ID. Research papers fulfilling all publication criteria will be published by our reputed college journal in a book form with ISBN following the seminar. Both qualitative and quantitative study can be accepted. Data can be cited from primary or secondary sources.
- For quantitative study, research scholars are directed to follow the following steps while presenting their topics: Introduction → Conceptual Framework
 → Objectives of the Study → Hypotheses/ Research Questions →
 Population and Sample Size → Sampling Techniques → Variables selected →
 Statistical Procedure → Major Findings → Conclusion and Suggestion(s).
- 3. For PPT presentation, Paper Presenters are directed to prepare their topics sincerely within 10 -12 slides by suing Microsoft Power Point 2010. All slides must be visible to the audience; hence Paper Presenters are requested to utilize a proper front size of the letter/ proper size of the picture/diagram.
- 4. Research Scholars are also directed to send their abstracts/full papers to subratalit3@gmail.com. as early as possible.
